Licenced Aircraft Maintenance Engineers (LAMEs) work on the whole range of aircraft, from simple piston engines to the cutting-edge technology in the latest civil and military jets.

The Civil Aviation Safety Authority (CASA) is offering scholarships to students seeking a career as a LAME.

The scholarship will provide \$1000 in support for each year in a two-year period. One scholarship will be available each year for each State and Territory. Payment will be provided for tools of professional quality, mandatory text books, and/or travel and accommodation to attend full-time theory training.

- Character reference from recent employer or headmaster.
- Most recent high school examination results, showing passes in physics and mathematics.
- Evidence of work experience in mechanical or electrical trade or technical enterprises.
- A statement written by the applicant outlining why the applicant is undertaking training as a LAME.
- Evidence of an employment commitment signed by the proprietor of an organisation holding a CASA Certificate of
- Approval for maintenance of Australian aircraft.
- Applications will be assessed by an expert panel drawn from CASA and professional associations.
- Application for LAME scholarship

The scholarship will provide \$1000 in support for each year in a two-year period. One scholarship will be available each year for each state and territory. Successful applicants will be selected from applications received by 28 November 2008.
