# **Purpose of this form**

Use this form to apply for a Part 138 Aerial Work Certificate and associated approvals under Part 138.

If you intend to apply for approvals, or a special flight authorisation, under Part 91 for your aerial work operations, apply using the relevant form – see question D2 for a list of applicable forms.

### Who is this form for?

This application form is for individuals or organisations who wish to apply for an initial issue Part 138 certificate.

This application form may be submitted to apply for significant changes, notification of non-significant changes, renewal or removal of aircraft or activities on a Part 138 Aerial Work Certificate.

If you are applying for an AOC at the same time as a Part 138 Aerial Work Certificate, including significant changes to be made to both certificates and associated separate approvals under Parts 91 and/or 138, complete the AOC Application Form.

You can also use this form to apply to become a carrier of dangerous goods cargo *(CASR Part 92)*. For full details on the carriage of dangerous goods refer to the <u>CASA website</u>.

# Information needed to complete this form

Current or proposed aerial work operators should review *CASR Parts 91, 138 and AC 92.A-01* before completing this form.

Aerial work operators must provide a Drug and Alcohol Management Plan (DAMP). If your organisation employs 10 or less Safety Sensitive Aviation Activity (SSAA) employees, you can access the Micro DAMP. For full details on DAMP's refer to the CASA website.

After receiving a completed application form, CASA will calculate and send you a cost estimate for the processing of your application (unless you are only notifying a non-significant change) and a list of any additional supporting documents required. You will need to pay the estimate and send additional supporting documentation with your payment before any assessment of your application occurs.

Note: Examples of operations involving a Class D external load are the following: winching a person on board from land or water; winching a person already aboard onto land or into the water; positioning a person on or at a transmission wire using a fixed line attached to the rotorcraft's belly hook; carrying a person on a platform; conducting a person's hover exit from, or entry to, the rotorcraft. The belly hook, winch, hard point, or platform must be approved for the purpose of the lifting, placement or carrying of the person (see for example, subsection 15.06 (4)). Only an aerial work certificate holder may carry out a Class D external load operation — see generally subregulations 138.005 (3) and 138.030 (1).

# Part F - Additional authorisations **Dangerous goods**

#### Acceptance and carriage of dangerous goods cargo (including COMAT)

For the carriage of dangerous goods in cargo, you will need to submit a dangerous goods manual in accordance with regulation 92.040. Refer to Advisory Circular AC 92-2: Dangerous Goods Manuals for more information regarding the regulatory requirements for a dangerous goods manual.

The acceptance and carriage of dangerous goods in cargo requires DG training, operational procedures (i.e. a dangerous goods manual) and the addition of specific clause(s) onto the Part 138 Certificate to approve this function.

COMAT is "company materials" such as aircraft spares or items intended as replacements for those which have been removed from the operator's aircraft and must be transported as dangerous goods in cargo (requiring DG training, documented procedures etc.). There are some concessions in relation to specialised packaging for COMAT, refer to Section 11.5 of Advisory Circular AC 92.A-01 for further information.

#### DG carried by passengers or crew

All Part 138 certificate operators are authorised to accept those limited dangerous goods permitted for carriage by passengers or crew in accordance with the provisions of Table 8-1 of the ICAO Technical Instructions for the Safe Transport of Dangerous Goods by Air (Doc 9284) (or industry equivalent document Table 2.3.A of the IATA Dangerous Goods Regulations (IATA DGR)) provided that the requirements of these provisions are detailed within your operations manual or exposition.
