Purpose of this form

This form is used by individuals to apply for an Air Transport Pilot Licence (ATPL-A) aeroplane category.

Who is this form for?

This form is for individuals who have successfully met the requirements to be issued an ATPL-A.

Information needed to complete this form

If CASA does not have a photo of the licence holder that is less than 10 years old, they must also submit [Lodgement of current photo with CASA \(Form 61-9PIC\)](#).

To be eligible for a ATPL-A, you must have passed all 7 subject part ATPL-A aeronautical knowledge exams for the aeroplane category or 3 aeroplane category part exams if the applicant holds a CASA issued Air Transport Pilot Licence - Helicopter.

CASA must ensure an applicant is a fit and proper person before issuing a permission.

A CASA Flight Crew Licence cannot be issued until an aviation security background check has been completed and has not been found adverse.
