Who is this form for?

This form is for individuals who wish to apply for an Australian CP(B)L.

Information needed to complete this form

To apply for a CP(B)L you must:

- be at least **18 years old**.
- Hold a current:
 - Private Pilot Certificate (Balloons)(PPC(B)); or
 - CASA Private Pilot (Balloon) Permit (PP(B)P); or
 - Part 131 ASAO pilot authorisation.
(CAR 5.138 and CASA EX76/24)
- Have held for at least one year a:
 - PPC(B); or
 - CASA PP(B)P; or
 - Part 131 ASAO pilot authorisation; or a certificate or licence issued by the competent authority of a foreign country that is at least equivalent to one of the above.
(CAR 5.138 and CASA EX76/24)
- Have the required aeronautical experience (CAR 5.145)
- have completed a course of balloon flying training (CAR 5.146)
- have passed a CP(B)L flight test (CAR 5.147(1))

If you are applying for a Flight Crew Balloon Licence on the basis of overseas qualifications use Form 1558.

If CASA does not have a photo of you that is less than 10 years old you must also submit a current photo with CASA Form 61-9PIC.

Aviation Reference Number (ARN)

An ARN is required to complete this form. If you do not have an ARN, [apply now](#).

If you are applying on behalf of an organisation, you will need to have authority to act on the entity's (applicant's) behalf and be able to provide the organisation's ARN.

- The aim of this test is to establish the candidate competence to exercise the privileges of a Commercial Pilot (Balloon) Licence. The flight test will consist of two segments:

- the first will be a typical balloon transport flight from take-off to final landing and may include an intermediate landing
- the second segment will be used to assess flight procedures and emergencies. The testing officer should be briefed as a passenger

Where flight conditions indicate continued flight in VFR may not be possible, or any other condition changes which would indicate that it would be prudent to terminate the flight, the candidate must exercise sound judgement in deciding whether to continue.

A consistent unsatisfactory final performance of any test item or procedure will result in an overall fail assessment for the flight test. The test may be discontinued at any point where a fail assessment is made. At the discretion of the testing officer, the candidate may be credited with a pass assessment in those test items successfully completed. The remaining items must be passed on re-test within 28 days.
