CASA 22/24 – Determination for the Part 133, Part 135 and Part 138 Manuals of Standards – Miscellaneous Minor Matters – Amendment Instrument 2024

1 Name

This instrument is *CASA 22/24 – Determination for the Part 133, Part 135 and Part 138 Manuals of Standards – Miscellaneous Minor Matters – Amendment Instrument 2024*.

2 Application

This instrument applies to the proposed instrument to be known as the *Part 133, Part 135 and Part 138 Manuals of Standards – Miscellaneous Minor Matters – Amendment Instrument 2024* (the **proposed MOS amendment**).

3 Determination

I determine that the amendments in the proposed MOS amendment which amend the following:

- (a) the *Part 133 (Australian Air Transport Operations—Rotorcraft) Manual of Standards 2020*;
- (b) the *Part 135 (Australian Air Transport Operations—Smaller Aeroplanes) Manual of Standards 2020*;
- (c) the *Part 138 (Aerial Work Operations) Manual of Standards 2020*;

(the **Part 133, Part 135 and Part 138 MOSs**) are of a minor or machinery nature that do not substantially alter existing arrangements under the Part 133, Part 135 and Part 138 MOSs or otherwise.
