CASA 70/22 — Determination for Part 138 MOS Amendment Instrument 2022 (No. 1)

1 Name

This instrument is *CASA 70/22 — Determination for Part 138 MOS Amendment Instrument 2022 (No. 1)*.

2 Application

This instrument applies to the proposed instrument to be known as the *Part 138 MOS Amendment Instrument 2022 (No. 1)* (the ***proposed MOS amendment***).

3 Determination

I determine that the proposed MOS amendment, which amends the *Part 138 (Aerial Work Operations) Manual of Standards 2020* (the ***Part 138 MOS***), is of a minor or machinery nature that does not substantially alter existing arrangements under the Part 138 MOS or otherwise.
