#### Purpose of this form

Use this form to apply for a standard exemption in accordance with Division 11.F.1 of CASR. A standard exemption is an exemption not issued in exceptional circumstances.

### Who is this form for?

This application form is for individuals or organisations who wish to apply for the initial issue of a standard exemption or the renewal of a standard exemption.

An application for renewal of an exemption is only considered by CASA to be a renewal where the legislative provision from which the applicant is requesting to be exempted is the same.

#### Information needed to complete this form

Exemptions are a kind of authorisation under CASR Part 11.

The applicant should review Division 11.F.1 of CASR to understand the requirements placed on exemption applicants and CASA.

The applicant should review the <u>Advisory Circular</u> on exemptions.

In addition, applicants should review the legislative provisions and guidance material that relates to the rules for which they are seeking an exemption, including any provisions relevant in a Manual of Standards (MOS), a Civil Aviation Order (CAO). They should also read any Acceptable Means of Compliance / Guidance Material (AMC/GM) document for the CASR Part within which the rule is located and any other relevant Advisory Circulars or Civil Aviation Advisory Publications.

After receiving a completed application form, CASA will calculate and send you a cost estimate for the processing of your application and a list of any additional supporting documents required.

You will need to pay the estimate and send additional supporting documentation with your payment before any assessment of your application occurs.

### **Aviation Reference Number (ARN)**

An ARN is an identifier that is similar to an account or customer number. You will need an ARN to complete this form.

If you do not have an ARN, apply for an ARN.

If you are applying on behalf of an organisation, you need to provide the organisation's ARN and have authority to act on behalf of the entity.

#### **Contact details**

CASA will use the currently held contact, ABN and ACN details linked to your ARN profile.

If your address, contact or other details have changed, you must update them online using <u>changing your details</u> prior to lodging this form.

Failure to provide up to date contact details to CASA could result in additional fees being charged under the Civil Aviation (Fees) Regulations 1995 and may constitute a criminal offence.

#### **Privacy**

CASA is required by CASR 11.225 to publish on the internet, details of any exemption. Any personal information you provide to CASA is protected by the Privacy Act 1988 (Cth). CASA can only collect, use and disclose that information in accordance with that Act.

CASA will use the information collected in this form for purposes associated with performing its functions under civil aviation legislation and other Australian laws.
