Direction under subregulation 2 (2) of CAR 1988 — tow targets and reeling machines

1 Application

This instrument applies to jettisonable aerial tow targets, and their reeling machines, that are attached to Australian aircraft for the purpose of use in weaponry trials and other exercises:

- (a) in Australia or any other country; and
- (b) by the Australian Defence Force or the military service of any other country.

2 Direction

Tow targets and reeling machines to which this instrument applies are deemed not to be aircraft components.
