

**Exemption — from minimum runway width instructions**

---

**1 Application**

This instrument only applies to DHC-8-100 type aircraft and DHC-8-300 type aircraft (the *aircraft*) operated by Skytrans Pty Ltd, trading as Skytrans Regional and Skytrans, Aviation Reference Number 584560 (the *operator*).

**2 Exemption**

The aircraft are exempt from compliance with the instructions in instrument CASA 204/11.

**3 Conditions**

The exemption is subject to the conditions mentioned in Schedule 1.

**4 Expiry**

This instrument stops having effect at the end of February 2012.

**Schedule 1 Conditions**

- 1 The aircraft must not land on, or take off from, a runway that is less than 18 metres wide.
  - 2 The operator must hold a current Air Operator's Certificate permitting landings and take-offs on that runway.
  - 3 For landing and take-off, the flight crew of the aircraft must comply with the conditions set out in the aircraft flight manual supplement for operations on a runway that is less than 23 metres wide.
