Exemption for Antonov An-124-100 aircraft operated by Antonov Airlines — minimum runway width instructions

1 Application

This instrument only applies to Antonov An124-100 aircraft (the *aircraft*) operated by Antonov Airlines, Aviation Reference Number 503013.

2 Exemption

The aircraft are exempt from compliance with the instructions in instrument CASA 61/12.

3 Conditions

The exemption is subject to the conditions mentioned in Schedule 1.

4 Expiry

This instrument stops having effect at the end of June 2015.

Schedule 1 Conditions

- 1 The aircraft must not land on, or take off from, a runway that is less than 45 metres wide.
 - 2 The operator must hold a current foreign aircraft AOC, or a permission under section 25 of the *Civil Aviation Act 1988*, which permits the aircraft to land on, or take off from, a runway that is 45 metres wide.
 - 3 The aircraft must only land, or take off, at an aerodrome that is named in the AOC or permission.
 - 4 For landing and take-off, the flight crew of the aircraft must comply with the conditions set out in the aircraft flight manual, or an equivalent document, for operations on a runway that is less than 60 metres wide.
