Exemption – Hervey Bay aerodrome – minimum runway width

1 Application

The instrument applies to Fraser Coast Regional Council, Aviation Reference Number 785036, as the operator of Hervey Bay aerodrome (the *aerodrome operator*).

2 Exemption

The aerodrome operator is exempt from regulation 139.165 of CASR 1998, in relation to the runway width required under paragraph 6.2.3 of the Manual of Standards Part 139 — Aerodromes (*MOS Part 139*), for use of the runway at Hervey Bay aerodrome by Airbus A320, Boeing 737-800 and Embraer 190 aircraft (Code 4 aircraft).

3 Conditions

The exemption is subject to the conditions set out in Schedule 1.

4 Expiry

This instrument stops having effect at the end of 28 February 2015.

Schedule 1 Conditions of exemption

- 1 The aerodrome operator must maintain a runway that is not less than 30 m wide.
 - 2 The movement area, in particular markings, markers, signals and lighting, must be maintained to the standard required under MOS Part 139.
 - 3 The aerodrome operator must provide specialised maintenance activities (rubber removal and friction testing).
 - 4 The operator must ensure that the obstacle limitation surfaces are regularly monitored to a 300 m inner edge as required for Code 4 operations (MOS Part 139, paragraph 7.1.4).
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
