Exemption — frangibility tests for light fittings at Port Macquarie aerodrome, New South Wales

1 Application

This instrument applies to Port Macquarie-Hastings Council, Aviation Reference Number 506564 (the *aerodrome operator*).

2 Exemption

In relation to the frangibility of the type F2-1 low intensity elevated light fittings (the *light fittings*) at Port Macquarie aerodrome, the aerodrome operator is exempt from compliance with subregulation 139.195 (3) of CASR 1998, in respect of paragraphs 9.1.11.1 and 9.1.15.2A of the Manual of Standards (MOS) Part 139 — Aerodromes.

3 Condition

The exemption is subject to the condition that the aerodrome operator must ensure that any damage to the light fittings is reported to CASA as soon as reasonably practicable.

4 Expiry

This instrument expires at the end of February 2014, as if it had been repealed by another instrument.
