Exemption – for Tennant Creek Airport Pty Limited – EMB 170 aircraft operations

1 Application

The instrument applies to Tennant Creek Airport Pty Limited, Aviation Reference Number 560170, as the operator of Tennant Creek Aerodrome (the *operator*), in relation to Embraer 170 aircraft (*EMB 170 aircraft*).

2 Exemption

The operator is exempt from compliance with regulation 139.040 of CASR 1998 in relation to the landing and taking-off of EMB 170 aircraft.

3 Conditions

The exemption is subject to the conditions set out in Schedule 1.

4 Expiry

This instrument expires at the end of 15 August 2014, as if it had been revoked by another instrument.

Schedule 1 Conditions

- 1 The operator must provide a copy of the latest instrument survey of the approach, take-off and transitional surfaces to operators of EMB 170 aircraft intending to use Tennant Creek Aerodrome.
- 2 The operator must have assessed the adequacy of the bearing strength of the movement area pavements for EMB 170 aircraft and issue a pavement concession, if necessary.
- 3 The operator must carry out an aerodrome serviceability inspection and record the results in the aerodrome reporting officer inspection log book on each day of a proposed EMB 170 aircraft movement.

- 4 The operator must advise the local emergency service agencies that EMB 170 aircraft will be operating at Tennant Creek Aerodrome and notify them of the maximum passenger carrying capacity of the aircraft.
 - 5 The operator must provide primary aircraft parking position markings on the main apron to ensure that any problem relating to jet blast is addressed.
