Exemption — provision of ARFFS at Coffs Harbour aerodrome

1 Definitions

In this instrument:

AA means Airservices Australia.

ARFFS means Aerodrome Rescue and Fire-Fighting Service.

ERSA means En Route Supplement Australia.

NOTAM means Notice to Airmen.

2 Application

This instrument applies to AA as the ARFFS providing Category 6 firefighting services at Coffs Harbour aerodrome.

3 Exemptions

- (1) AA is exempt from compliance with paragraph 139.712 (f) of CASR 1998 in respect to paragraph 9.1.1.1 of the Manual of Standards (MOS) – Subpart 139.H.

Note Paragraph 9.1.1.1 requires that where an ARFFS is established, operational hours must be published in ERSA.

- (2) AA is exempt from compliance with subregulations 139.711 (1), 139.770 (1) and 139.775 (1) of CASR 1998.

4 Condition

The exemptions are subject to the condition that AA must publish the operational hours of the ARFFS via NOTAM and note that the ARFFS is a “non-accredited” service.

5 Expiry

This instrument expires at the end of December 2015, as if it had been revoked by another instrument.
