Exemption – dry chemical powder – Administration of Norfolk Island

1 Application

This instrument applies to the Administration of Norfolk Island (the *ARFFS provider*).

2 Exemption

- (1) The ARFFS provider is exempt from compliance with regulation 139.785 of CASR 1998 to the extent mentioned in subsection (2).
- (2) The exemption in subsection (1) is only to the extent that the ARFFS provider is required by paragraph 7.1.3.1 of the Manual of Standards (MOS) — Subpart 139.H (the *MOS*) to maintain a reserve supply of complementary agent and expellant gas cylinders equivalent to 200% of the quantities of those agents to be provided in the rescue and firefighting vehicles for the aerodrome category on the aerodrome for replenishment purposes.

Note Under subsection 7.1.3.1 of the MOS, a reserve supply of foam concentrate, complementary agent and expellant gas cylinders equivalent to 200% of the quantities of those agents to be provided in the rescue and firefighting vehicles for the aerodrome category must be maintained on the aerodrome for vehicle replenishment purposes.

3 Condition

The exemption is subject to the condition that the ARFFS provider must maintain a reserve supply of complementary agent and expellant gas cylinders, equivalent to the quantities of those items to be provided in the rescue and firefighting vehicles for the aerodrome category, on the aerodrome for replenishment purposes.

4 Expiry

This instrument expires at the end of June 2018, as if it had been revoked by another instrument.
