**Medical Certification Standards,
Discussion Paper**

On the 26 March this year at a regular General Meeting of the East Gippsland Aero Club (EGAC) at Bairnsdale, eight actively flying members with an average of 30 years of flying experience all indicted that of the CASA options 1-6 (Medical Certification Standards Discussion Paper December 2016 P6) option 5 was the unanimous nomination.

The meeting had a total attendance of 23 including visitors and non-flying family members so the 8 responders represent the opinions of 73-80% of active flying members.

There were two additional comments and they were "take into account O.S. experience i.e. UK, USA, N.Z. France" and " similar to US restrictions, i.e. 6000lbs AUW, twins etc"

The whole meeting unanimously agreed that CASA should proceed as fast as possible with Option 5. Developing a new medical certificate "for the sport and recreational sectors which considers overseas approaches with elements of self certification." Note Option 6. Was not selected by anybody.

We ask that these views from concerned aviators with considerable experience be accepted by CASA as comments as requested.
