CASA EX71/18 — AW169 Type Rating Training Endorsement (Michael Anthony Tavcar) Exemption 2018

1 Name

This instrument is *CASA EX71/18 — AW169 Type Rating Training Endorsement (Michael Anthony Tavcar) Exemption 2018*.

2 Exemption

- (1) Michael Anthony Tavcar, ARN 149765, is exempt from compliance with paragraphs 61.1250 (2) (b) and (c) of CASR to the extent that compliance is necessary to be eligible for the grant of a type rating training endorsement for the AgustaWestland AW169 type.
- (2) The exemption is subject to the conditions mentioned in section 3.

3 Conditions

- (1) Michael Anthony Tavcar must provide the following documents, or certified copies of the following documents, to CASA before the day this instrument is repealed:
 - (a) his training records and course completion certificate that relate to his attendance in 2018 at the AW169 helicopter type rating instructor course conducted by AgustaWestland S.P.A., ARN 223622;
 - (b) a flight test report signed by an examiner authorised by the European Aviation Safety Agency that indicates that Michael Anthony Tavcar was assessed in 2018 as competent to be an AW169 helicopter type rating instructor.
- (2) Michael Anthony Tavcar must not apply for the grant of a type rating training endorsement for the AgustaWestland AW169 type to a person other than CASA.

4 Repeal

This instrument is repealed at the end of the earlier of the following days:

- (a) 31 July 2018;
 - (b) the day on which CASA grants a type rating training endorsement for the AW169 type to Michael Anthony Tavcar under regulation 61.170 of CASR.
