Purpose of this form

Use this form to apply for an initial issue, renewal of, or changes to general approvals issued under Part 91 of the *Civil Aviation Safety Regulations 1998* (CASR).

Who is this form for?

This application form is for individuals or organisations who wish to apply for initial issue approvals, renew, remove or make changes to their existing approvals under CASR Part 91.

This application form is not for operators who hold, or are applying for, an Air Operator's Certificate (AOC). AOC operators should apply for Part 91 approvals using the <u>Air Operator's Certificate / Associated Approvals</u> application form.

For applications related to air displays, use the <u>Approval to conduct Air</u><u>Display</u> application form.

For applications related to low visibility operations, use the <u>Part 91</u> <u>approval Low Visibility</u> application form.

For applications related to operations in RVSM airspace and RNP-AR instrument approaches, use the <u>Navigation authorisation - RNP AR and RVSM</u> application form.

For applications relating to minimum equipment lists, use the <u>Minimum</u> <u>Equipment List</u> application form.

Information needed to complete this form

Persons that do not hold or are not applying for an Air Operator's Certificate (AOC) or Part 138 certificate who wish to apply for general approvals should review CASR Part 91 before completing this form.

After receiving a completed application form, CASA will calculate and send you a cost estimate for the processing of your application and a list of any additional supporting documents required. You will need to pay the estimate and send additional supporting documentation with your payment before any assessment of your application occurs.

Aviation Reference Number (ARN)

An ARN is required to complete this form. If you do not have an ARN, <u>apply now</u>.

If you are applying on behalf of an organisation, you will need to have authority to act on the entity's (applicant's) behalf and be able to provide the organisation's ARN.

Contact details
