Purpose of this form

Use this form to apply for an initial issue, renewal of, or changes to general approvals issued under CASR Part 91.

Who is this form for?

This application form is for individuals or organisations who wish to apply for initial issue approvals, renew, remove or make changes to their existing approvals under CASR Part 91.

For applications related to Low Visibility and PBN Operations, please refer to Part 91 Approvals - Low Visibility and PBN Operations (Form CASA-04-5691).

Information needed to complete this form

Persons that do not hold or are not applying for an Air **Operator's Certificate (AOC) or Part 138 certificate** who wish to apply for general approvals should review CASR Part 91 before completing this form.

After receiving a completed application form, CASA will calculate and send you a cost estimate for the processing of your application and a list of any additional supporting documents required. You will need to pay the estimate and send additional supporting documentation with your payment before any assessment of your application occurs.

Aviation Reference Number (ARN)

An ARN is an identifier that is similar to an account or customer number. You will need an ARN to complete this form.

If you do not have an ARN, apply for an ARN.

If you are applying on behalf of an organisation, you need to provide the organisation's ARN and have authority to act on behalf of the entity.
