## 1. Effectivity

All Cessna 172N Models and Lycoming O-320-H2AD Engines

## 2. Purpose

To alert owners, operators, maintainers and parts distributors that suspected unapproved parts have been sold without FAA production approval.

## 3. Background

A FAA audit of Superior Air Parts discovered that crankshaft bearings, part number SL14105A M03 were sold without FAA production approval. The FAA subsequently released Unapproved Parts Notification (UPN) No 2012-20120104008, dated 27 July, 2012.

## 4. Recommendations

CASA recommends that aircraft owners, operators, maintainers and parts distributors review the latest revision of [FAA Unapproved Parts Notification \(UPN\) No 2012-20120104008](#) and inspect their aircraft records and parts inventory for the identified suspected unapproved parts.

If any of these suspect parts are found in existing stock, it is recommended the unapproved parts are segregated to prevent inadvertent installation. If a part has been identified already installed on the aircraft, it is recommended that the part be removed immediately.
