Purpose of this form

Use this form to apply for Aircraft Type Ratings on an Australian Aircraft Maintenance Engineer Licence, based on training with a CASA approved Maintenance Training Organisation (MTO).

Who is this form for?

This form is for individuals applying for additional privileges on their aircraft maintenance licence via training with a Maintenance Training Organisation (MTO) or Approved Maintenance Organisation (AMO).

Information needed to complete this form

You must be licenced within the applicable Category for which you seek an Aircraft Type Rating before submitting this application **OR** be submitting Form 540 at the same time.

This form is not for recognition of qualifications via Australian Defence Force, or Foreign Civil qualifications. You should use the appropriate forms.

If you are applying for additional ratings based on Australian Defence Force (ADF) use Form 543, If applying based on Foreign Civil Qualifications (FCQ) use Form 545.

Please ensure your application and the checklist are completed correctly and that all required supporting documentation is provided. Incomplete applications will not be accepted and may be returned to you for amendment.
