## **Purpose of this form**

This form is used to apply to CASA for a Special Flight Permit (SFP) to allow the operation of an aircraft that does not meet its airworthiness requirements but under certain circumstances, and for a particular intended purpose, the aircraft may still be capable of safe flight.

## Who is this form for?

This form is for any person wishing to apply for a special flight permit for the special purposes identified in CASR 21.197 and detailed in section 5 of this form.

## Information needed to complete this form

Information regarding the status of aircraft configuration and maintenance history will be required by the applicant. In addition, specific information regarding the purpose will also be required for the application to be considered.

## **Aviation Reference Number (ARN)**

An ARN is required to complete this form. If you do not have an ARN, apply now.

If you are applying on behalf of an organisation, you will need to have authority to act on the entity's (applicant's) behalf and be able to provide the organisation's ARN.
