Purpose of this form

Use this form to apply for an Australian Aeroplane MPL where you have been Australian civil trained.

Who is this form for?

This form is for individuals who are Australian civil trained, have passed the relevant aeronautical knowledge exams and wish to apply for an Australian MPL.

Information needed to complete this form

You must provide certified copies of documents as a part of this application. For more information on certified copies and who can witness them, see the <u>CASA website</u>.

A CASA Flight Crew Licence cannot be issued until you have been issued with an Aviation Security Identification Card (ASIC) or Aviation Identification (AVID). For security requirements associated with the issue of this licence please refer to the guidelines.

To be issued with a flight radio endorsement based on your pilot certificate, you will need to hold a valid International Civil Aviation Organisation (ICAO) level 4, or higher, Aviation English Proficiency (AELP) assessment or you are submitting an AELP notification with this application.

To be eligible for an MPL, you must have passed relevant Aeronautical Knowledge Exams. The Result Advice/Knowledge Deficiency Report (RA/KDR) must be provided to the Flight Examiner for review.

- CLWA + CADA + CFPA + CHUF + CMET + CNAV + CSYA - 7 subject-part exams; and
- AALW + AASA + AFPA + AHUF + AMET + ANAV + APLA - 7 subject-part exams; and
- IREX
