CASA EX58/25 — Aeroplane Aerial Application Endorsement (Charlie Endres) Exemption 2025

1 Name

This instrument is CASA EX58/25 — Aeroplane Aerial Application Endorsement (Charlie Endres) Exemption 2025.

2 Definitions

Note In this instrument certain terms and expressions have the same meaning as they have in the *Civil Aviation Act 1988* and the regulations, including *CASR*.

In this instrument:

aerial application endorsement has the meaning given by regulation 61.010 of CASR.

aeroplane aerial application endorsement means the endorsement set out in item 1 of table 61.1120 of CASR.

applicant means Charlie Graeme Endres, ARN 812911.

direct supervision has the meaning given by subregulation 61.1130(3) of CASR. *relevant requirement* means the requirement to have at least 200 hours of flight time as pilot of an aeroplane, as set out in column 3 of item 1 of table 61.1120 of CASR.

3 Exemptions

- (1) Subsection (2) applies to the applicant, when applying for the grant of an aerial application rating, or aeroplane aerial application endorsement, based on meeting the requirements set out in regulation 61.1140 of CASR for the grant of an aeroplane aerial application endorsement, if the applicant has at least 150 hours of flight time as pilot of an aeroplane.
- (2) The applicant is exempt from compliance with:
 - (a) the relevant requirement for the purposes of paragraph 61.1115(1)(b) of CASR; and

(b) the relevant requirement for the purposes of paragraph 61.1140(2)(b) of CASR.

4 Condition

- (1) This condition applies if the applicant:
 - (a) is granted the rating or endorsement referred to in subsection 3(1); and
 - (b) is not relying on the criterion set out in paragraph 61.1130(1)(a) of CASR for the exercise of the privileges of the rating or endorsement.
- (2) The applicant must ensure that, in addition to the 10 hours of direct supervision required by subparagraph 61.1130(2)(b)(i) of CASR, at least 70 hours of the supervision set out in subparagraph 61.1130(2)(b)(ii) of CASR are also direct supervision.

5 Repeal

This instrument is repealed at the end of 31 May 2028.
