Appointment of authorised persons to endorse or cancel endorsements on maintenance releases

1 Comencement

The instrument commences on 27 June 2011.

2 Revocation

Instrument CASA 128/95 is revoked.

3 Definitions

CAR, followed by a reference, means the provision of CAR 1988 denoted by the reference.

CASR, followed by a reference, means the provision of the *Civil Aviation Safety Regulations 1998* denoted by the reference.

4 Appointment of authorised persons to endorse or cancel maintenance releases

I appoint each person included in the class of persons mentioned in an item in Schedule 1, to be an *authorised person* for the provision of CAR 1988 mentioned for the item, subject to any conditions mentioned for the item.

Note The powers of the authorised person for the relevant provision of CAR 1988 concern endorsing, or cancelling the endorsement on, a maintenance release mentioned in the provision.
