CASA 44/22 — Determination for *Part 149* (Approved Self-administering Aviation Organisations) Amendment Manual of Standards 2022 (No. 1)

1 Name

This instrument is CASA 44/22 — Determination for Part 149 (Approved Self-administering Aviation Organisations) Amendment Manual of Standards 2022 (No. 1).

2 Application

This instrument applies to the proposed instrument to be known as the *Part 149* (*Approved Self-administering Aviation Organisations*) Amendment Manual of Standards 2022 (No. 1) (the **proposed MOS amendment**).

3 Determination

I determine that the proposed MOS amendment, which amends the *Part 149* (*Approved Self-administering Aviation Organisations*) Manual of Standards 2018, is of a minor or machinery nature that does not substantially alter existing arrangements.
