CASA EX27/24 — Part 61 (Flight Examiner Endorsements) (Anthony Stanton) Exemption 2024

1 Name

This instrument is *CASA EX27/24 — Part 61 (Flight Examiner Endorsements) (Anthony Stanton) Exemption 2024*.

2 Definitions

Note In this instrument, certain terms and expressions have the same meaning as they have in the *Civil Aviation Act 1988* and the regulations. These include **examiner** as defined in the CASR Dictionary.

In this instrument:

relevant person means Anthony Alfred Stanton, ARN 442616.

flight examiner endorsement has the meaning given by regulation 61.010 of CASR.

flight test endorsement has the meaning given by regulation 61.010 of CASR.

3 Exemptions — requirements for grant of flight examiner endorsements

- (1) Subsection (2) applies if the relevant person makes an application for the grant of any of the following flight examiner endorsements:
 - (a) a private pilot licence flight test endorsement (item 1 of table 61.1310 of CASR) in the aeroplane category;
 - (b) a commercial pilot licence flight test endorsement (item 2 of the table) in the aeroplane category;
 - (c) an instrument rating flight test endorsement (item 6 of the table) in the aeroplane category;
 - (d) a night VFR rating flight test endorsement (item 7 of the table) in the aeroplane category.
- (2) For the purposes of regulation 11.160 of CASR, the relevant person is exempted from compliance with paragraphs 61.1320(2)(a) and (b) of CASR in relation to the application.

4 Exemption — conducting flight tests in aircraft

- (1) Subsection (2) applies if the relevant person is granted a flight test endorsement mentioned in paragraph 3(1)(a), (b), (c) or (d).
- (2) For the purposes of regulation 11.160 of CASR, the relevant person is exempted from compliance with regulation 61.1318 of CASR in relation to conducting a flight test under the flight test endorsement.

5 Repeal

This instrument is repealed at the end of 24 April 2027.
