# CASA 35/23 — RPAS BVLOS OCTA Aeronautical Knowledge Examination Approval 2023

#### 1 Name

This instrument is CASA 35/23 — RPAS BVLOS OCTA Aeronautical Knowledge Examination Approval 2023.

#### 2 Definitions

Note In this instrument, certain terms and expressions have the same meaning as they have in the Civil Aviation Act 1988 and the regulations. These include: CASR, controlled airspace, examination, operated within the visual line of sight, remote pilot licence, RPA and RPAS.

#### (1) In this instrument:

RPAS BVLOS OCTA Aeronautical Knowledge Examination means an examination, administered by CASA, that is a test of the syllabus and standards set out in the document CASA-04-6380, titled RPAS Beyond visual line of sight (BVLOS) outside of controlled airspace (OCTA) - Aeronautical Knowledge Standards, Version 1.0, dated June 2023, as it exists at the time this instrument commences.

(2) In this instrument, an RPA is operated *beyond visual line of sight* of the person operating the RPA if it is not operated within the visual line of sight of the person.

### 3 Application

The approval in section 4 applies to a person who holds a remote pilot licence and:

(a) operates an RPA that is beyond visual line of sight of the person and outside controlled airspace; or

(b) supervises the operation by a pilot of an RPA that is beyond visual line of sight of the pilot and outside controlled airspace.

## 4 Approval

The RPAS BVLOS OCTA Aeronautical Knowledge Examination is approved as an approved examination for subparagraph 101.300(4)(a)(iii) of CASR.

*Note* The approval does not apply to the operation of an RPA in controlled airspace.

## 5 Repeal

This instrument is repealed at the end of 31 May 2028.
