CASA EX15/24 — Schiebel S-100 RPA (Wedgetail Aerospace) Exemption 2024

1 Name

This instrument is *CASA EX15/24 — Schiebel S-100 RPA (Wedgetail Aerospace) Exemption 2024*.

2 Duration

This instrument:

- (a) commences on 1 April 2024; and
- (b) is repealed at the end of 31 March 2027.

3 Definitions

In this instrument:

approved area has the meaning given by regulation 101.236 of CASR.

chief remote pilot has the same meaning as in paragraph 101.340(1)(a) of CASR.

Outram means Liam Reginald Outram, ARN 783110, in his capacity as a remote pilot employed or engaged by Wedgetail.

Penfold means Stephen John Penfold, ARN 501690, in his capacity as Wedgetail's chief remote pilot.

relevant RPA means a Schiebel S-100 RPA, for which Wedgetail holds:

- (a) a current experimental certificate; or
- (b) a current approval under regulation 101.275 of CASR.

Wedgetail means Wedgetail Aerospace Pty Ltd, ARN 1148053.

4 Exemptions

Outram and Penfold are exempt from compliance with subregulations 101.252(2) and (3) of CASR if they operate the relevant RPA:

- (a) at or below 400 feet AGL; and
 - (b) in an approved area for the operation; and
 - (c) within Australian territory; and
 - (d) in accordance with any conditions of the approval of the area imposed under subregulation 101.030(6) of CASR; and
 - (e) if the relevant RPA is operated under an experimental certificate issued for the relevant RPA — in accordance with any conditions imposed on the experimental certificate that are relevant to the operation of the RPA; and
 - (f) if the relevant RPA is operated under an approval under regulation 101.275 of CASR — in accordance with any conditions imposed on the approval that are relevant to the operation of the RPA.
