Purpose of this form

Use this form to register for a commercial or air transport pilot licence or flight engineer licence in recognition of equivalent New Zealand (NZ) qualifications in accordance with the *Trans-Tasman Mutual Recognition Act 1997* (TTMRA).

Who is this form for?

This form is for individuals who have a NZ Flight Crew Licence and wish to register for the Australian equivalent.

Information needed to complete this form

You must complete NZ Licence Verification form CAA602 and send it to the <u>Civil Aviation Authority of New Zealand</u> (CAANZ).

You need to hold a:

- current Flight Crew Licence and a current class 1 medical; or
- provide sufficient logbook evidence for all privileges you are applying for.

You are required to hold at least a current ICAO level 4 English Language Proficiency assessment.

If CASA does not have a photo of you that is less than 10 years old, you must also submit <u>Lodgement of current photo with CASA (Form 61-9PIC)</u>.

Where a NZ pilot converts any operational ratings (instrument, instructor, etc.) under TTMRA, you must complete an Australian proficiency check before you can utilise the rating. Validity of your NZ rating is not transferable.

Ensure you provide a correctly completed Commonwealth of Australia Statutory Declaration (template is attached to this form) by an approved witness.

Key information about completing Australian Statutory Declarations:

- An approved witness must have a professional connection to Australia
- Having the required connection to Australia means the person is either:
 - licensed or registered to practise in Australia.
 - holds an Australian membership to a relevant professional organisation.
 - appointed in Australia.
 - the only exception are notary publics who may be registered as notary publics by an overseas entity and do not need to be registered in Australia to be an approved witness.
