### **CASA EX152/21 — Minimum Height and Lateral Separation (Aerotech First Response Pty Ltd) Exemption 2021**

---

**1 Name**

This instrument is *CASA EX152/21 — Minimum Height and Lateral Separation (Aerotech First Response Pty Ltd) Exemption 2021*.

**2 Duration**

This instrument:

- (a) commences on 1 December 2021; and
- (b) is repealed at the end of 30 November 2024.

**3 Definitions**

In this instrument:

***arranged firefighting operation*** means a firefighting operation conducted under an arrangement or agreement between Aerotech First Response Pty Ltd, ARN 525279, and an emergency service organisation.

***relevant aeroplane*** means an aeroplane operated by Aerotech First Response Pty Ltd.

**4 Application**

This instrument applies in relation to Aerotech First Response Pty Ltd.

**5 Exemption**

The pilot in command of a relevant aeroplane, engaged in an arranged firefighting operation, is exempt from compliance with subregulation 137.140 (3) of CASR to the extent the aeroplane is being used to drop water or a retardant over an occupied building or an area adjacent to an occupied building, as directed by an emergency service organisation.
