Purpose of this form

This form is used to apply to CASA for a Permissible Unserviceability that may allow continued operation of aircraft with defects and/ or damage by identifying or deactivating inoperable equipment and rendering the systems unavailable for use by the operating crew.

Who is this form for?

This form is used to apply to CASA for a Permissible Unserviceability that may allow continued operation of aircraft with defects and/ or damage by, for example, identifying or deactivating inoperable equipment and rendering the systems unavailable for use by the operating crew, under regulation 21.007 of the Civil Aviation Safety Regulations 1998 (CASR).

Information needed to complete this form

Information regarding the status of aircraft configuration and maintenance history will be required by the applicant. In addition, specific information surrounding the reasons for the unserviceability will need to be submitted and assessed prior to any approval.

Recommended Guidance:

A permissible unserviceability is not an MEL extension, see Advisory Circular 21-28 — Permissible unserviceabilites — unrepaired defects (r21.007) for complete guidance.

Aviation Reference Number (ARN)
