This data sheet is part of type acceptance certificate No. A120 which is issued under regulation 21.029A of the Civil Aviation Regulations 1998. It lists the conditions and limitations under which aircraft of the type for which the type acceptance certificate was issued meet the airworthiness requirements of the Civil Aviation Safety Authority.

Conditions and limitations:

Modification PAC/CR/0295 deletes the engine secondary air inlet door. Aeroplanes without the secondary air inlet door are not eligible for certificates of airworthiness in the normal category.

Note:

Cresco 08-600 aeroplanes in the former agricultural category were accepted in Australia under Certificate of Type Approval No. A115 which was issued under regulation 22 of the Civil Aviation Regulations in force at 31 March 1998.
