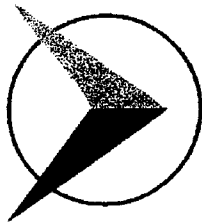

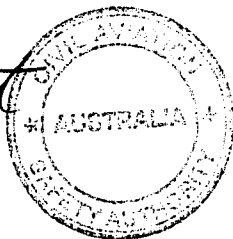
Pursuant to Regulation 22A of the Civil Aviation Regulations this certifies that approval is granted for the model Bantam B22S aeroplane.

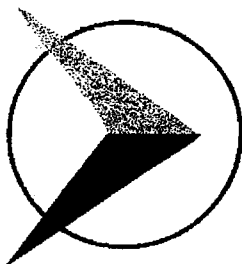
