TYPE ACCEPTANCE CERTIFICATE DATA SHEET

This data sheet is part of Type Acceptance Certificate (TAC) No. A162, Issue 2, which is issued under regulation 21.29A of the Civil Aviation Regulations 1998

The basis for certification is TCDS A25CE issued by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) of the USA and Civil Aviation Order (CAO) 101.4 as applicable.

Eligibility for Certificate of Airworthiness – Normal Category:

To be eligible for a Certificate of Airworthiness in the Normal Category the aircraft must be shown to comply with TCDS A25CE issued by the FAA.

Eligibility for Certificate of Airworthiness – Transport Category

To be eligible for a Certificate of Airworthiness in the Transport Category (CAO 82.3 Paragraph 6.1.a) the aircraft must be shown to comply with TCDS A25CE issued by the FAA and the requirements prescribed in CAO 101.4.
