TYPE ACCEPTANCE CERTIFICATE DATA SHEET

This data sheet is part of Type Acceptance Certificate (TAC) No. A209 and has been issued to specify the certification basis for Australian acceptance of the SAAB 2000 aircraft.

Certification Basis:

The basis of certification is as prescribed in Type Certificate No. A1/94 issued by the Swedish Civil Aviation Administration (LFV) and Type Certificate Data Sheet JAA/25/94-006 issued by the Joint Aviation Authority (JAA) and accepted by the European Aviation Safety Agency (EASA).

LFV Type Certificate A1/94, in conjunction with JAA TCDS JAA/25/94-006, is taken to be a Type Certificate issued by EASA under a "grandfathering" agreement in accordance with European Commission Regulations (EC) 1592/2002 and 1702/2003.
