This Type Acceptance Certificate is issued for the Alexander Schleicher GmbH & Co. ASK 21 models ASK 21, ASK 21 B and ASK 21 Mi in accordance with regulation 21.029A of the *Civil Aviation Safety Regulations 1998*.

Aircraft of the type and model covered by this certificate are eligible for Australian certificates of airworthiness in the utility category. The ASK 21 and ASK 21 B are eligible for an Australian certificate of airworthiness in the aerobatic category when meeting the minimum equipment requirements listed in the type certificate data sheet.

Both ASK 21 and ASK 21 B are sailplanes. The ASK 21 Mi is a powered sailplane. A.287 issue 2 includes the model ASK 21 B.

This type acceptance certificate supersedes GFA certificate of type acceptance No. 001 (issue 1) dated 29 October 1991 for the ASK 21 sailplane and type acceptance certificate A.287 (original issue) dated 16 September 2013 for the ASK 21 and ASK 21 Mi. All certificates of airworthiness issued under GFA certificate of type acceptance No. 001 (issue 1) and type acceptance certificate A.287 (original issue) remain valid.

This certificate is valid until suspended or cancelled by the Civil Aviation Safety Authority. The basis of certification is as prescribed in Type Certificate Data Sheet No. A.221 (replaces LBA TCDS No. 339) issued by the European Aviation Safety Agency.
