The aircraft must have been issued with:

a) an Austrian Certificate of Airworthiness for Export signed by a representative of the Bundesamt Fur Zivilluftfahrt (BAZ);

or

b) A Certificate of Airworthiness for Export signed by the Airworthiness Authority of a country with whom Canada has a Bilateral Airworthiness agreement;

In the case of a) or b), the C of A for Export must contain the following statement:

"The aircraft identified by this Certificate has been examined and found to conform to the Canadian Department of Transport Aircraft Type Approval A-189."

or

c) A Certificate of Airworthiness for Export or a current Certificate of Airworthiness issued by the Canadian Department of Transport;

or

d) A manufacturer's compliance statement specifying that the aircraft complies with Canadian Department of Transport Aircraft Type Approval A-189.

Any conditions or restrictions placed on this aeroplane by the Canadian DOT in addition to those of the BAZ will automatically apply to Australian registered aeroplanes.
