Eligible Serial Numbers:



Conditions and/or Limitations:

 - (iii) Fire Fighting (21.25 (2) (c))

- 2 Scott's – Bell 47, Inc. U.S. Army Model OH-13H helicopters are eligible to be modified to M74L configuration in accordance with NOTE 3 of TCDS H7SW.
 - 3 Texas Helicopter Company Inc Service Instruction No. SI-006A or later approved revision specifies the US FAA approved Mandatory Retirement Schedule for Time Life Limited Components for the M74L.
 - 4 Any conditions or restrictions placed on this aircraft model by the FAA will automatically apply to Australian registered aircraft.
