Purpose of this form

Use this form to request CASA to deregister an aircraft from the Australian Civil Aircraft Register that is subject to an **Irrevocable De-registration and Export Request Authorisation (IDERA) or Certified Designee Confirmation Letter (CDCL)**.

Who is this form for?

This form is for the **authorised party** under the IDERA or the **certified designee** under the CDCL to request CASA to deregister an aircraft from the Australian Civil Aircraft Register.

Information needed to complete this form

Where both, a certified designee and an authorised party are noted, only the certified designee can complete and sign this form.

This form has specific power of attorney requirements in relation to signatures. CASA recommends that applicants complete as much of the form electronically as possible, noting that we do not accept electronic signatures for this form.

If a Power of Attorney is required and is executed in a foreign jurisdiction, the Power of Attorney must be accompanied by a letter from a law firm in that foreign jurisdiction, addressed to the person submitting the de-registration request and copied to CASA, certifying that the Power of Attorney has been done in accordance with the laws of that foreign jurisdiction and that the Power of Attorney has been properly executed and is effective in that jurisdiction.

Aviation Reference Number (ARN)

An ARN is required to complete this form. If you do not have an ARN, [apply now](#).

If you are applying on behalf of an organisation, you will need to have authority to act on the entity's (applicant's) behalf and be able to provide the organisation's ARN.
