FLYING FPV.

Flying first person view (FPV) relays live video to goggles, mobile phone or your tablet screen.



You can fly FPV indoors for sport or recreation provided the drone stays within the building.

If you want to fly FPV outdoors, you must either:

- be a member of a model aircraft association that has approval to fly FPV
- apply for CASA approval via our website.

Flying your drone FPV can decrease your situational awareness and increases the risk of your drone colliding with trees, people, birds or aircraft.

Drones are fun, and by following the simple rules, we can all enjoy the air together.
