



AvSafety podcast – Weather in a changing environment

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(1)	Lea Vesic relates her experience of flying in a changing weather environment. She says her instructor warned her that the weather was likely to become marginal quickly, but that her eagerness to get into the aircraft clouded any looming concerns about a change in the weather. Has this ever happened to you? If so, what happened?
(2)	Lea was surprised to see multiple aircraft heading inbound as she tracked towards the far end of the training field. If you were in a similar situation, considerations would you make?
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(3)	Reflect on previous flights. How do you maintain composure in challenging situations in the aircraft?

(5)	When flying, or preparing for a flight, have you ever misinterpreted the weather or made a decision that, in hindsight, you would have done differently? Explain.
(6)	What were some of the key lessons Lea learned from her experience?

(7)	Reflect on the last flight you took. What plan B, did you put it into action? What other decisions did you make?
(8)	How do you go about implementing lessons learned from your own flight experiences?
