CASA OAR 017/24 – Temporary Restricted Area – Declaration and Determination (Fraser Group TIBA) Instrument 2024

1 Name

This instrument is CASA OAR 017/24 – Temporary Restricted Area – Declaration and Determination (Fraser Group TIBA) Instrument 2024.

2 Duration

This instrument:

- (a) commences on 25 January 2024; and
- (b) is repealed at the end of 25 January 2024.

Note Dates in this provision are in Coordinated Universal Time (UTC).

3 Declaration of temporary restricted area

- (1) I declare the area specified in Schedule 1 to be a temporary restricted area.
- (2) Any conditions in accordance with which the flight of aircraft within the area is permitted are set out in Schedule 1.

4 Activation of declaration

The declaration of the area specified in Schedule 1 is activated by the event mentioned in the activation clause for the area.

5 Determination that ATS are at variance with Annex 11

(1) I determine that, in accordance with Annex 11 to the Chicago Convention, the air traffic services (*ATS*) to be provided for the airspace within the declared area are services that are at variance with the ATS that would otherwise be provided, in accordance with the Annex, for the airspace within the declared area.

(2) The services that are at variance are set out in Schedule 1.

6 Directions instrument for temporary restricted areas outside Australian territory

This instrument operates subject to the effect of CASA 57/23 – Australian-administered Airspace outside Australian Territory – Temporary TIBA Areas – Directions Instrument 2023.

Schedule 1 Specification of temporary restricted area and

ATS variance

Description: The temporary restricted area is established across southern

Queensland and north-eastern New South Wales within Class A, C, E and G airspace due to the lack of air traffic control services and the application of traffic information broadcast by aircraft

procedures.

Particulars of Air Traffic Services: Within the restricted area air traffic control services will not be provided in Class A, C and E airspace. Traffic information and surveillance information service not available in Class G airspace.
