CASA OAR 082/24 – Temporary Restricted Areas – Declaration and Determination (BASS Group TIBA) Instrument 2024

1 Name

This instrument is *CASA OAR 082/24 – Temporary Restricted Areas – Declaration and Determination (Huon Sector TIBA) Instrument 2024*.

2 Duration

This instrument:

- (a) commences on 03 May 2024; and
- (b) is repealed at the end of 03 May 2024.

3 Declaration of temporary restricted areas

- (1) I declare each area specified in Schedule 1 to be a temporary restricted area.
- (2) Any conditions in accordance with which the flight of aircraft within an area is permitted are set out in Schedule 1.

4 Activation of declaration

The declaration of each area specified in Schedule 1 is activated by the event mentioned in the activation clause for the area.

5 Determination that ATS are at variance with Annex 11

- (1) I determine that, in accordance with Annex 11 to the Chicago Convention, the air traffic services (*ATS*) to be provided for the airspace within each declared area are services that are at variance with the ATS that would otherwise be provided, in accordance with the Annex, for the airspace within the declared area.
- (2) The services that are at variance are set out in Schedule 1.

6 Directions instrument for temporary restricted areas outside Australian territory

This instrument operates subject to the effect of *CASA 08/23 – Directions – TRAs and TDAs outside Australian Territory – Instrument 2023 (No. 1)*.

Schedule 1 Specification of temporary restricted areas and ATS variance

Description TRA-HUON/ TASMANIA:	The temporary restricted area is established across Bass Group, which includes Class A, C and E airspace. This is due to the lack of air traffic control services and the application of traffic information broadcast by aircraft procedures.
Particulars of Air Traffic Services:	Within the restricted area air traffic control services will not be provided. Traffic information and surveillance information service not available in Class G airspace.
Lateral limits:	Within the Designated Airspace Handbook, published sector volumes known as HOBART APPROACH, LAUNCESTON APPROACH, and HUON A, B and C.
Vertical limits:	Surface to FL600.
Activation clause:	Activated in accordance with NOTAM.
Conditions of entry:	Flight is not permitted within the temporary restricted area without the approval of the controlling authority.
Controlling Authority:	Airservices Australia.
