



Video recording sheet (Secondary): Note-taking

During the video: in the NOTES section, take short dot point notes about the important things that are mentioned.

During and after the video: in the QUESTIONS section, note down any questions you have that you want to follow up on later. Asking questions will engage your higher-order thinking, and help you make better connections with what you are learning.

After the video: in the SUMMARY section, write one or two sentences that summarise what you have learned. Writing a summary will help consolidate your understanding of the important things you have learned and connect it with prior knowledge.
