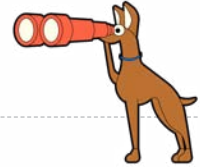


Questions and options: score 1 point for each correct answer.

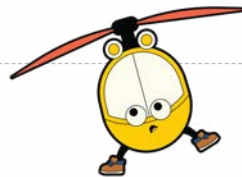
