



Part E – Regular Public Transport Operations

You must complete Part E if you intend to carry passengers or cargo for hire or reward **to and from fixed terminals over specific routes and on a fixed schedule**.
A Subpart 42.G CAMO certificate must be issued for aircraft that are operating CAR 206 (1) (c) RPT operations. You must also complete [Form 42-01 - Application for CASR 42 Approval Certificate](#)

#CASA is transitioning to the new regulations which will require all Regular Public Transport AOC holders to comply with the requirements of the new CASR Part 42 regulation.

While Columns 9, 10 and 11 above address the requirements of the new CASR Part 42, you may still apply for an AOC under the old maintenance regulations during the transition period. However, given the transition period ends on 26 June 2013, CASA strongly recommends you apply under the new CASR Part 42 maintenance regulation.
