



Important Information for Applicants

- The form contains the process and information for the Application, Assessment and Approval of a Certificate of Airworthiness due to a Change of Registration Mark ONLY. Change of Registration Mark processes are contained in [guidelines](#) for [Form 023](#) 'Application for a Change of Registration Mark'.
- Completion and submission of this form constitutes a request to Re-issue the CofA due to a Change of Registration Mark. No further application is necessary however a change of Mark may affect other approvals such as RVSM and PBN which require other processes.
- If the application is not from the Registration Holder a letter of authority from the registration holder will need to be available. Please see applicant's declaration for this form.
- CASA processing and consideration of this application is cost recoverable at an hourly rate under Section 9.6 of the [Civil Aviation \(Fees\) Regulation 1995](#). A cost estimate will be forwarded to the applicant for applicable payment before the task can commence. If the processing and assessment is via an appropriate IOA Holder the payment/fee processes are provided by them.
- An application submitted to CASA should be submitted to the Regional Office where the aircraft file is held. This will most likely be the office in the geographical area of the aircraft's main location. We term this 'your Regional Office'.
- CASR 21.173 states that 'An aircraft registration holder, or the owner of an aircraft that is registered with a sport aviation body, is eligible to apply for a certificate of airworthiness'.
- The approval of the certificate of airworthiness under this process is via CASR 21.176 and only an appropriately delegated or authorised individual may issue.
- This form is an electronic form intended to be completed on a PC and either embedded with an electronic signature (picture) and submitted in an email, or printed and signed, scanned and attached to an email and sent to the appropriate CASA regional office or an appropriate Instrument of Appointment (IOA) Holder.

The form is in several sections to facilitate the completion and processing of the change of registration mark. Sections A through D are to be filled out by the applicant who then submits the form to either a CASA regional office or an authorised person who has powers under CASR 21.176.

- The registration mark may be pen-amended to reflect the new mark. The amended document must clearly identify the current registration mark and serial number of the aircraft, as appropriate.



- Any pen-amendments must be in ink, initialled and dated. The amended document, as changed, must remain clear and legible.
- If the application is to be completed by CASA the Regional Office must complete Section F and issue the replacement CoA. If the application is to be completed by an authorised person then they must complete Section G and issue a new CoA under CASR 21.176.
