Exemption — Qantas for persons conducting training and checking functions

1 Application

This instrument applies to Qantas Airways Limited, ARN 216147 (*Qantas*), if:

- (a) Qantas employs or engages the following persons:
 - (i) Alex Campbell-Dixon, ARN 1014395;
 - (ii) Ricki Coldicutt, ARN 1014443; and
- (b) the persons conduct the following training and checking functions for Qantas:
 - (i) emergency procedures proficiency checks as under *Civil Aviation Order 20.11 (as amended)*, as in force from time to time;
 - (ii) CAAP SMS-3(1) human factors training under *Civil Aviation Order 82.5 (as amended)*, as in force from time to time;
 - (iii) dangerous goods training under Part 92 of CASR, as in force from time to time; and
- (c) the persons are suitably accredited to conduct the training and checking functions; and
- (d) the persons conduct the training and checking functions in accordance with Qantas's operations manual, as existing when this instrument is signed.

2 Exemption

Qantas is exempt from paragraph 2.4 of Appendix 2 to *Civil Aviation Order 82.5 (as amended)*, as in force from time to time in relation to the persons conducting the training and checking functions.

3 Repeal

This instrument is repealed at the end of 30 April 2020.
