Approval — to publish aeronautical maps, charts and other aeronautical information and instructions

1 Application

This instrument applies to BJA Consulting Pty Ltd, Aviation Reference Number 823783 (the *publisher*).

2 Approval

I approve the publisher to publish the aeronautical maps, charts and other aeronautical information and instructions mentioned in Schedule 1 for use in Australian airspace.

3 Interpretation

Terms used in Schedule 1 have the same meaning as in AIP.

4 Conditions

The approval is subject to the conditions mentioned in Schedule 2.

5 Expiry

This instrument expires, as if it had been repealed by another instrument, at the end of 31 July 2016.

Schedule 1

The publisher's AvPlan EFB product, to the extent of aeronautical maps, charts and other aeronautical information specified in the exposition submitted to CASA by the publisher (the *exposition*), including the following:

- (a) AIC;
- (b) AIP;
- (c) DAP;

- (d) ERC H/L;
- (e) ERSA;
- (f) PCA;
- (g) VNC;
- (h) VTC; and
- (i) WAC.

Schedule 2 Conditions

- 1 The publisher must comply with the exposition.
 - 2 The publisher must not make a change to the publication of any product mentioned in Schedule 1 unless the change to the exposition regarding that change has been approved by CASA. A change to the publication of any product includes:
 - (a) ceasing the publication of previously published information as well as publishing new material; and
 - (b) any change to the area of coverage for any product.
 - 3 An application for approval of a change under clause 2 must:
 - (a) be in writing; and
 - (b) set out the change; and
 - (c) be accompanied by a copy of the part of the exposition affected by the change, clearly identifying the change.
 - 4 The publisher may make a change, to a matter mentioned in the exposition, other than a change mentioned in clause 2, if it has:
 - (a) amended its exposition to reflect the change; and
 - (b) given CASA written notice of the change and a copy of the amended part of the exposition clearly identifying the change.
 - 5 If any changes are made to the exposition under clause 2 or 4, CASA must be provided with a copy of the exposition as finally amended.
 - 6 CASA may direct changes to the publisher's exposition.
 - 7 If CASA directs changes to the publisher's exposition, the publisher must comply with those changes.
 - 8 The publisher must inform CASA in writing of any of the following changes, other than a change to which clause 2 or 4 applies:
 - (a) changes that materially affect the production by the publisher of maps, charts and other aeronautical information and instructions;
 - (b) changes to the publisher's Safety Management System;
 - (c) correction of any errors or omissions in maps, charts and other aeronautical information and instructions that were introduced by the publisher.
 - 9 The publisher must give access to CASA inspectors to audit and inspect its systems and processes on production of a valid CASA identification.
